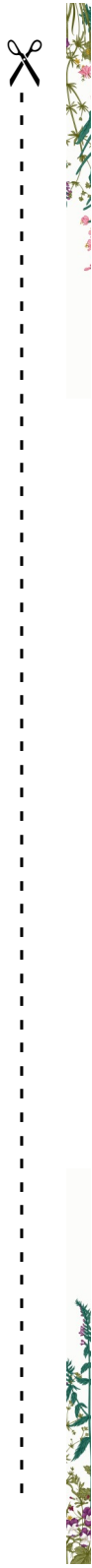

1. All horticultural exhibits must have been grown by the exhibitor on their allotment or garden
2. The exhibit must be the property of the exhibitor
3. No exhibitor will be allowed to enter more than one entry in any one class
4. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry on reasonable grounds. In the event of such refusal the committee is not required to give any explanation
5. Judges will be appointed by the committee, their decision will be final
6. The committee reserves the right to have the ground and produce inspected before or after the show
7. Entry fee for all classes will be 50p each, except for children's classes which are free of charge. Children entering other classes will be required to pay the entry fee.

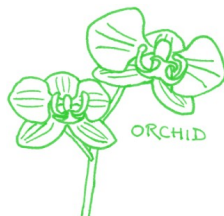
