Rent Increases

In response to the rising cost of living, the government has announced that there will be a cap on rent increases for social housing tenants across the country. This means that rents will increase by up to 7% from 1st April 2023. The cap is designed to keep rent levels down for tenants, in light of the current high levels of price inflation.

Watford Community Housing is carrying out a consultation with tenants to make sure that vital services are maintained while keeping rents affordable. There will be an online survey that residents can complete, or you can go along to one of the following events:

- 30th November – 6.30pm-8pm: Consultation event for tenants – Leavesden Green Community Hub
- 1st December – 6.30pm-8pm: Consultation event for shared ownership customers – Gateway House, Clarendon Road
- 12th January – 6.30pm-8pm: Consultation event for leaseholders – Gateway House, Clarendon Road
